Young people in grades 1-3 are invited to come to the library to discuss the book of their choice and enjoy dessert.

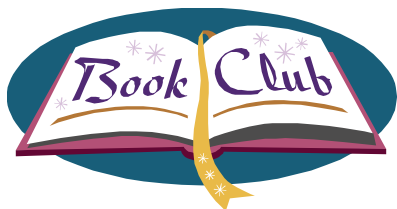
Brown Bag Lunch Book club
